



India in 2061

- The ratio of men to women 52.2 : 47.8 %; Average family size of 4 as against 5 now
- The biggest Muslim population in the world
- Digitally the language web will dominate India
- The country will essentially be urban; number of cities to 143
- Self-contained apartment blocks or country side
- Urban challenges: water, infrastructure, electricity, public transport, parking, garbage disposal, and security
- Big cities will be run like countries; American large city model of governance
- India will be a richer country; huge boom in travel, luxury services, and financial products



- Care services for the old, lifestyle services for the middle aged and nurturing services for the young will be in demand In 2061, India will be a middle aged plus senior citizen society
- Television and the internet will possibly merge into a virtual screen device; Internet availability in every household will be freely available
- Digital cities, digital homes, driverless cars, electric cars, connected homes and connected everyday things;
- Technology will be huge enabler and the backbone will be mobile technology and the internet. an enabler; Digital privacy and security big;
